Our Services

One On One Music Lessons

Age 5+; rates vary depending on # of students per day and # of lessons per package.

Personalized to each student's interests and goals in music. Students learn the language of music through their favorite genres of music and artists they know. To build their craft, students learn technique, theory and music performance while playing their favorite songs. As well, songwriting and composition techniques are covered.

Semi-Group Music Lessons: 1-5 people

Age 5+; rates vary depending on # of students

Semi-group music lessons are conducted in an environment where students can ask questions about music and learn through songs they listened to during the week. Classes are personalized to each group's abilities and interests with a focus on playing songs and learning the language of music.



Rock Band Group Music Lessons: average 8-12 people per class

In Rock Band group music lessons, chosen songs are personalized to each specific group's song tastes and performing experience. Whether your students have never played an instrument before or are looking to develop their skills playing together, Rock Band is a great way to help grow your students music appreciation and educate them in a fun environment. We provide instructors that work with each student to help them work together with the band and play songs. Lessons are taught at your school with the students or school's instruments. Additional cost for us to bring the instruments.

Choir

Student learn to sing and the intricacies of the voice including tone, pitch, and technique. Learning outcomes include collaborations skills, reading music, and performing experience. Depending on the requested learning style, our instructor(s) can develop the choir program to teach in a certain genre of music such as classical, jazz, pop, rock, and more. Generally, we recommend to have the choir program on a weekly basis to prepare for your choir's bi-annual performance.

Songwriting Workshops

Perfect for choirs or assemblies, the songwriting workshop teaches students how to craft their own songs, inspire their creativity and raise their self confidence to perform on stage. As well, students craft an original song together as a class during a workshop. What students learn in this workshop can also be applied in other areas of their academic life. Subjects covered include voice, melodies, brainstorming, collaboration, performance and creative writing. Sessions are generally 1 hour to 1.5 hours for both one time and ongoing programs.



Instrument Masterclasses

We work with your school's band instructor to help supplement band students music progress. Students in the specific band section (ie. percussion, saxophone, etc) break out into specific training for their instrument. This masterclass workshop is popular for instruments include saxophone, trumpet, trombone, drums/percussion, clarinet, flute, tuba, and more.

Strings Program

In the strings ensemble, students have the choice to learn the violin, viola, cello, or double bass. Students learn how to play their instrument, read music, and perform in front of a live audience. In addition to learning music skills, students learn how to work together and the value of self discipline through practicing music.

Group Music Lessons (seminar style)

Age 5+ (for age 5 to 9, parent or teacher accompanied required)

One instructor teaches from on stage and has a pre-set curriculum that they will teach to all students. Students learn the language of music and instrument technique through learning their favorites songs. Common instruments are guitar, ukulele, recorder, etc. *Attendees music bring their own instrument. Additional cost for us to bring the instruments.

Interactive Music Kiosk for Events

Our kiosk provides opportunities for visitors to try out instruments - guitar, drums, bass, piano, percussion - have questions answered, and to play music.

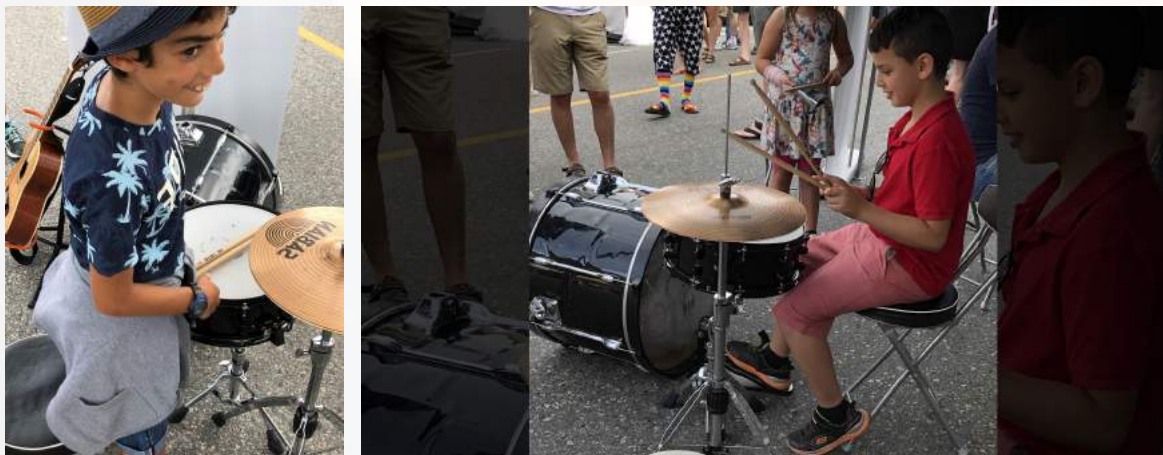
We have different types of instruments, including a drum kit, electric guitar and ukulele, that few children are able to experience. Children have the opportunity to be taught a few chords by our onsite instructors and learn about music.
